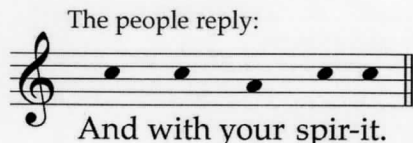


## ✦ Gloria

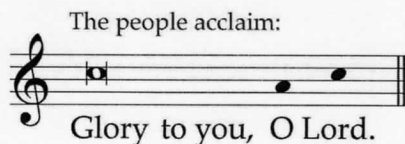
Glory to God in the highest,

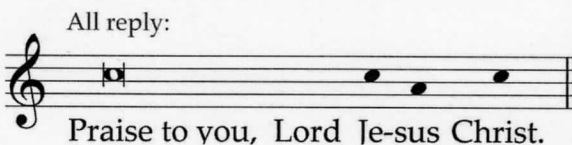

## ✦ Nicene Creed

and life everlasting. Amen.

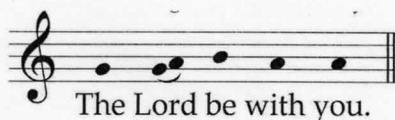
### ✦ The Preparation of Gifts

may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father.

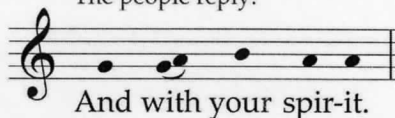


**Memorial Acclamation**

Then the Priest sings:





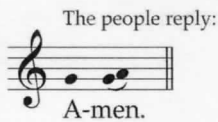
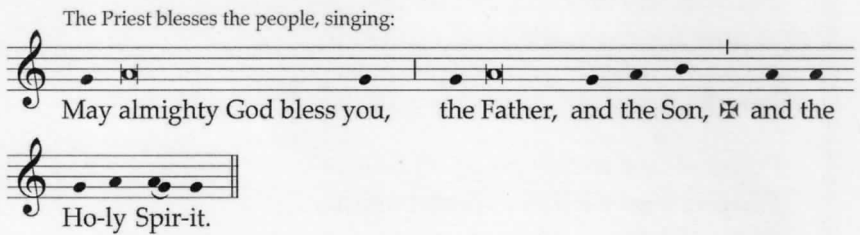
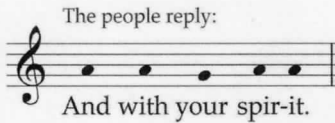
### ✦ Invitation to Communion
